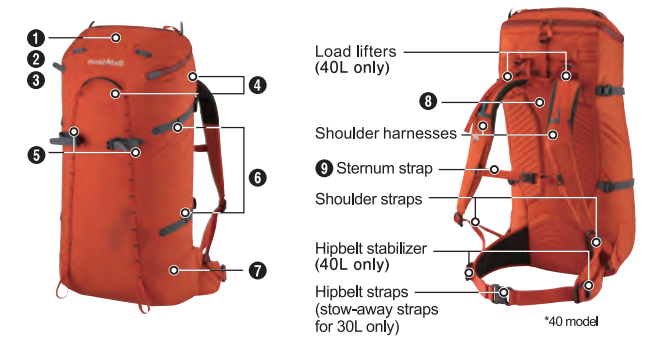
User's Manual

Thank you for purchasing this product. Before using, please carefully read this manual for instructions on the proper care and usage of this product. Description

These medium volume backpacks feature superior water resistance and excellent fit. Well suited for overnight trips and trekking. The 40L model has a 3D Fit Aluminum Frame. The 30L model has a foam backpanel that can also be removed from the backpacks and used as a mat. Includes a rain cover for the top of the pack.

Features



- 1 A discrete internal zippered security pocket for storing small items.
- 2 Trapezoid shaped top lid delivers more head clearance for better vision and comfort.
- 3 4 loops located on the top of the pack for securing items with 20mm straps (sold separately).
- 4 Hand loops on the front and back of the backpack for easier carrying.
- 5 Easy attachment loop for climbing tools.
- 6 Compression straps allow you to address varying internal pack volume, attaching skis or stowing trekking poles.
- 7 Two side pockets for transporting tent poles or trekking poles.
- 8 Rain cover for protecting the top of the backpack.
- 9 Sternum strap can be adjusted vertically to customize the shoulder harness.

Hydration Compatible

This pack is compatible with hydration bladders.

Hydration bladders are sold separately.

Hang the hydration bladder from the loop on the inside of the back and slide it into the pocket. Pull the hose through the Hose Port to the left or right, depending on your preference.

Pass the hose through the loop on the shoulder harness and adjust the position of the mouth piece. The hose can also be attached to the sternum strap.

Attaching rain cover

Take the rain cover out of the pocket at the top of the back panel and align the montbell logo on the front panel logo to attach correctly.

Attach the rain cover's hooks to the loops on the left and right shoulder straps. Depending on the volume of the pack, attach the clips to the gear loops on the front panel.

*The Ridge Line series features seamed seals for improved water resistance. However the back panel and top of the backpack are not seam sealed and these areas have water resistance equal to that of standard backpacks.

Fitting Process

1 Adjusting the stabilizers

Before starting, unbuckle and loosen all straps. To simulate conditions during actual use, load about 10kg of weight into the backpack.

Shoulder the product and fasten the hipbelt, taking care not to put pressure on your abdomen.

Pull the shoulder straps so that they tighten around your shoulders and armpits.

Pull the load lifters to draw the backpack's center of gravity in closer to your body.(40L only)

Pull the hipbelt stabilizers to prevent the backpack from shifting left and right.(40L only)

Fasten the sternum strap and adjust its position about 5cm below your collarbone to prevent the shoulder harnesses from shifting position.

⑥ Check fit and if there are any gaps between your body and the pack start over from step 2 (40L only)

2 Adjust the 3D Fit Aluminum Frame (40L only)

The 3D Fit Aluminum Frame inside this product has been pre-bent to fit the curve and shape of the back. In most cases, it can be used as is. If there are any gaps between the backpack, your shoulders and back, please use the following instructions to make any necessary adjustments.

- ① Remove any items inside the backpack and be sure to perform any adjustments when the backpack is empty. Check the location of the 3D Fit Aluminum Frame (see illustration below) and bend it while inside the backpack using your legs.
 - Do not remove the 3D Fit Aluminum Frame.
 - Make sure to bend the left and right sides of the frame at the same time.
 - Make minor, gradual adjustments to the frame and avoid swift, major adjustments.
- ② After adjusting 3D Fit Aluminum Frame, start over from step 1-1.



The fitting of your backpack is now complete. Depending on what you wear you may need to make minor adjustments to the shoulder straps, load lifters, and hipbelt straps. Fasten straps so that they are secure, but do not cause discomfort.

Care

Improper care and storage of your backpack can shorten its lifespan. Follow the recommendations below to extend the lifespan of your backpack.

- To clean stains and soiling, lightly rinse off and use a mild soap with a sponge to brush away any remaining residue. Rinse off and hang to dry in the shade.
- Water repellency will decrease over time. To restore water repellency, first clean any residues from the fabric surface and then apply a water repellent spray (sold separately).
- Do not dry clean or wash in a washing machine. These methods may damage the backpack's fabric.

Storage

- Store in a well ventilated, cool, dry place.
- Do not store together with corrosive materials.

Warranty

Montbell's warranty covers all defects in materials and workmanship to the original owner, for the lifetime of the product. If a product ever fails due to a manufacturing defect, Montbell will repair or replace the product at our discretion. This warranty does not cover damage(s) caused by accident, improper care, negligence, misuse, alterations or normal wear and tear.
